Tigers have reddish-orange fur with dark stripes. They have long tails that help them keep their balance.

Tigers eat meat. They usually hunt alone in the dark. Tigers can eat as much as 60 lbs of meat in one night but usually they eat around 12 lbs a meal.

Tigers live solitary lives. They know when they have entered another tiger's territory because each tiger marks the trees in their area with urine and scratches.

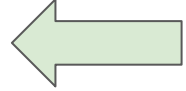
Tigers are in jeopardy in their natural habitats because of overhunting and loss of habitat from human land use.

- Tigers usually live 16-18 years.
- Adult tigers can run 30-40 mph for a short time
- Male tigers weigh 200-670 lbs.
- Female tigers weigh 140-370 lbs.
- Tigers can jump 20-30 feet
- Tigers are good at swimming
- Tigers roar loud! They can sometimes be heard as far as two miles away.
- Tigers can jump 20-30 feet in one jump!
- Tigers are the biggest species in the cat family

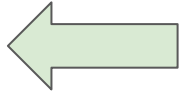
